Marriages require a six month preparation period by Diocesan policy. Call one of the parish priests prior to setting a date.

Funerals are at 10:00 am. Arrangements are to be made at the Parish Office before publication of the death notice.

Ministry to those who are Sick or Shut-In

Our Eucharistic Ministers can bring the Eucharist to those parishioners who are ill, recovering from a hospital stay, shut-in, or otherwise unable to attend the Liturgies each Sunday. Please call the Parish Office to be placed on the schedule.

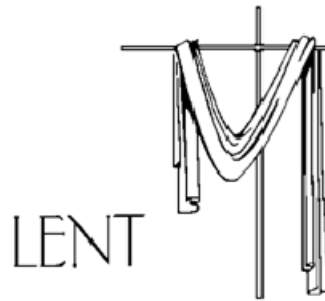

EVANGELIZATION

BE WITH ME

It's been said that he who sings prays twice. Singing a beautiful hymn engages our emotions as well as our minds. During the liturgical Stations of the Cross, we sing verses from the hymn "At the Cross Her Station Keeping" - and rightly so. No one was more deeply immersed in Christ's passion and death than Mary.

Probably the most soul-stirring Lenten hymn we know is "Were You There." Number 583 in our hymnals applies this beautiful melody to each one of the fifteen Stations. The Stations of the Cross set to music can be our own private devotion at home, before or after Mass, or during Eucharistic adoration. For each Station we can substitute "Were you there" with "Jesus, I am here with You" - as You see Your mother weep. . . As they nail You to the cross. . . as You rise up from the dead.

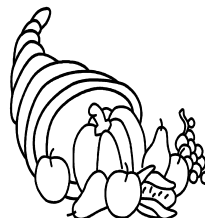

Deacon Ken and Sandy Hill offered a Lenten Afternoon of Reflection this past Sunday which began with 12:00 pm Mass and continued with a light luncheon, viewing a well-produced video on Divine Mercy, discussion, and the recitation of the Rosary and the Divine Mercy Chaplet. The afternoon concluded with exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Benediction. I'd like to thank Deacon Ken and Sandy and all who were in attendance for making it a wonderful and holy afternoon. The Divine Mercy Chaplet is recited in front of the Blessed Sacrament here at St. Vincent de Paul on the First Sunday of the Month at 3:00 pm in our Church. Benediction concludes the afternoon. Please consider taking advantage of this powerful means of God's mercy. Parents and grandparents can use this prayer for their loved ones who have fallen away from the Church. I personally believe that this, as well as the Eucharistic Adoration that takes place each Saturday between 3:30 pm and 4:30 pm has helped to strengthen our parish.

The schedule for Holy Week has been finalized. The **Sacrament of Reconciliation** will be offered on Saturday, March 19th, as usual from 3:30 pm to 4:30 pm. In addition, the opportunity for Confession will also take place Monday evening, March 21st, after the 6:00 pm Mass from 6:30 pm - 7:30 pm and Spy Wednesday, March 23rd, after the 6:00 pm Mass until 8:00 pm.

The **Mass of The Lord's Supper** will take place on Holy Thursday at 7:00 pm. The Blessed Sacrament will be reposed on the Holy Family Altar until 10:00 pm.

Good Friday there will be an opportunity to attend and pray the Stations of the Cross at 12:00 pm. At 3:00 pm in the afternoon, there will be the opportunity to attend the Good Friday Passion of the Lord Liturgy that includes the opportunity to venerate the Cross.

On **Holy Saturday** at 12:00 pm, we will have the annual Easter Egg Hunt. At 1:00 pm, we will offer the traditional Blessing of the Food.

The **Easter Vigil** will be at **9:00 pm**. (Please note there will not be a Saturday 5:00 pm Vigil Mass on Holy Saturday in accordance with Church Law.)

Easter Sunday the Mass times will be 8:00 am, 10:30 am & 12:00 pm.
