# PASTOR'S NOTES

Dear Parishioners,

Last week my Pastor's Column should have included Fr. Clancy and Deacon Ken Hill next to my name at the bottom of the letter. They too are grateful for everyone who made Holy Week and Easter a wonderful celebration here at St. Vincent de Paul.

Speaking of Deacon Hill, he informed me that we had sixty people present for the celebration of Divine Mercy last Sunday at 3:00 pm. As you know, our Parish offers the opportunity to pray the Divine Mercy Chaplet and the Rosary with Benediction to the Blessed Sacrament on the first Sunday of each month at 3:00 pm. We are fortunate to have an active Deacon and his wife, Sandy, who are willing to commit their time for this prayerful devotion.

Now for a bit of housekeeping news. Last week the installation of L.E.D. lights began on the exterior of the school building. This will help to better illuminate our grounds at night hopefully discouraging loitering and vandalism. Also it should help decrease our electric bills.

Secondly, I recently signed a contract with a Diocesan approved contractor to patch the roof of the school. One of the items the building inspector noticed when he was here was the water damage on the top floor of the building. I met with the roofing contractor who had assessed the building accompanied by Scott Meade, our plant manager. He showed me at least 30 pictures he had taken of the entire roof. The pictures included flashings, drains etc. as well as a core sample of the current roof. His suggestion was a new roof because the current one is really deteriorating and in fact is no longer being installed on new applications. I chose to go with the temporary fix until we have the benefit of rental income. I also learned from the Diocese that this particular company also offers a maintenance program. This program includes inspecting the roof twice a year and making simple repairs. I think by being proactive it will save us money in the future.

One final note about roofs. The School roof and the roof of the De Paul Center were done at the same time in early 2000. Pray that the Senior Housing becomes a reality and the State of Ohio awards Catholic Charities the grant to proceed. If this happens we won't

have to worry about the maintenance on the De Paul Center or the Lighthouse.

Finally, GALA and the Bellaire Puritas Association are hosting a Town Hall Meeting here in the Social Hall this Tuesday evening at 6:30 pm to discuss the proposed playground for the school and other pertinent matters. Please know you are most welcome to attend.
