REJOICE

"Hail Mary, full of grace." (Luke 1:28)

On Monday, April 4, the Church celebrated the feast of the Annunciation, the occasion of Christ's Incarnation. Ordinarily this blessed event is honored on March 25, but this year the date was Good Friday.

Interestingly, the Greek word which means "Hail" can also be translated as "Rejoice." Certainly Mary had every reason to rejoice as the Son of God, the world's Savior, became her own precious baby. Now, during the Easter season, Mary's happiness abounds even more. "Rejoice and be glad, O Virgin Mary Alleluia. For the Lord (your Son) has risen indeed. Alleluia!" (The Regina Caeli)

We too can be glad every day, that the mother of Jesus is our mother too. "Hail Holy Queen, Mother of Mercy, our life, our sweetness, and our hope!"

PASTOR'S NOTES

Dear Parishioners,

At my first assignment at Holy Family Parish in Parma, we had a tradition for Mother's Day and Father's Day. The parishioners received a Mother's Day Envelope in their Church Envelope Packet for May and a Father's Day Envelope in their June Packet. Beginning Mother's Day weekend, the Mother's Day Envelopes would be placed on the Altar and remain there until the end of the Month. The Father's Day Envelopes would be placed on the Altar on the weekend of Father's Day and remain on the Altar until the end of June. At this time we do something similar in November with All Souls. The names of our loved ones are written on the envelopes so they can be part of our November Masses. I added the Mother's and Father's Day Envelopes to our parish packet because I wanted to start that tradition here. We will include something in our weekend "Prayers of the Faithful" during those months to acknowledge those listed on the envelopes. For example, for those listed on the Mother's Day Envelopes something like, "for all those mentioned on the Mother's Day Envelopes located on the Altar." We would acknowledge those listed on the Father's Day Envelopes in the same manner in June. Please know that any contribution placed in the envelope would be put into the Parish Mass Fund. If you do not receive our church envelopes, you may use a plain white envelope marked "Mother's Day" and add the name of your loved one.

At a recent Coffee and Donut Sunday, members of the Marketing Committee asked for some feedback from those in attendance about what type of activities they would like to see at Saint Vincent de Paul. The most popular by far was the opportunity to gather together for a good meal at a reasonable price. Recently, the Boy Scouts offered a Pasta Dinner fundraiser. It was very well attended. Those who came to the event commented on the quality as well as the affordability.

On Sunday, April 24th, there will be another opportunity to gather for a meal. This time it will be for a Pancake Fundraiser for Girl Scout Troop 70116. The event will take place in the Social Hall. The Girl Scouts will be serving food from 8:30 am to 12:30 pm in the Church Hall. The funds raised from this breakfast will benefit the Girl Scouts' trip to the birthplace of the founder of the Scouts in Savannah, Georgia.

Finally, mark your calendars and plan on attending the Annual Parish Picnic which will take place on Sunday, June 26th. The Marketing Committee is holding a Bake Sale on Mother's Day to help defray some of the costs of the

picnic. We are in need of bake goods for this event. Please consider donating one of your favorite baked goods, or if you don't have time to bake, stop off at your favorite bakery. Members of the Committee will be receiving any and all goodies on Saturday, May 7th, from 11:00 am to 1:00 pm at the East entrance doors of the Church that also leads to the Social Hall. The Bake Sale itself will take place after the 8:00 am, 10:30 am and 12:00 pm Masses or until they run out of bakery.
