### Ministry to those who are Sick or Shut-In

Our Eucharistic Ministers can bring the Eucharist to those parishioners who are ill, recovering from a hospital stay, shut-in, or otherwise unable to attend the Liturgies each Sunday. Please call the Parish Office to be placed on the schedule.

**EVANGELIZATION**

**SAINT JOHN VIANNEY**  
***Patron saint of parish priests***

In the grand scheme of holiness, there's a place for everyone - no matter how adrift, untalented, or unspectacular we may sometimes feel.

John Vianney was born in 1786, in Dardilly, France. Never a good student, he achieved barely passing grades in school. Nevertheless, despite many setbacks and problems, his longing for the priesthood was realized. Ordained in 1815, he became the Cure` (parish priest) of Ars. There he found his niche. Within two years, thousands were drawn to his confessional. The devoted pastor had the gift of reading hearts and souls. He gave common-sense advice, inspiring genuine conversion of people's lives. He was also blessed with the power to heal illnesses, and restore peace and happiness. Father Vianney died in 1859, and was canonized in 1929.
