"Ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; Knock and the door will be opened for you."
(Luke 11:9)

Luke 11:1-13 is the parable about one friend pestering another in the middle of the night, for an urgent favor. We can sympathize with both friends, but I think we prefer the inconvenience of being disturbed, rather than the embarrassment of having to take advantage of a friend's generosity. Jesus tells us that, when it comes to prayer, the pestering friend should be our model of persevering petition.

In some countries the phrase "God botherer" is used as a derogatory term for Christians. The parable shows us that our Heavenly Father not only tolerates, but actually urges us to bother Him constantly with our requests big and small. How and when He answers our prayers is up to Him. It's up to us to keep on knocking.
