**BRIDGING THE GAP**

“Moreover, between us and you, a great Chasm is established.” (Luke 16:26)

Today’s gospel is the parable about the rich man and poor Lazarus. After death they found themselves on opposite sides of the great divide: Lazarus in a good place, and the rich man in a very bad place. If only in life the rich man had shared his advantages with the beggar - perhaps death would have deposited both of them on the heavenly side of that chasm, safe “in the bosom of Abraham.”

We’re reminded of the Simon and Garfunkel song: “Like a bridge over troubled waters, I will lay me down.” If ever anyone actually did such a thing, it was Christ. By emptying Himself of heavenly wealth, He bridged the gap between heaven and earth. He made Himself the bridge we must cross from our side to His. We know the bridge is made of love. Generosity is what gets us from here to there.
