**ARE YOU REGISTERED IN OUR PARISH?** If you are an adult and you are not receiving envelopes, we might not have a record of you. Without this record, we would not be able to help you when you want to get married, have a child baptized or if you are asked to be a Sponsor or Godparent for Baptism or Confirmation. To be a sponsor or Godparent, you must have a Sponsor Certificate from us stating that you are a practicing Catholic which means you made your First Communion, were Confirmed, and if married, you were married in the Catholic Church, and attend Mass regularly.

If you move and do not notify us, your envelopes are returned to us and you are deleted from our church roster. Also, if you get married and wish to remain a parishioner, just give us a call at the rectory so that we can update our records.
