**EVANGELIZATION****OUR LADY OF LOURDES - FEBRUARY 11**

# PASTOR'S NOTES

Dear Parishioner's,

Last week I had the opportunity to travel to Amish Country with a fellow Priest, Fr. Schwet. You may know him. He helped out at the parish last January for a few weekend Masses while I was away. On the way down to the restaurant we passed a Catholic Church which is part of the Diocese of Youngstown. We looked at the weekend Mass Schedule and noticed that of the two Masses offered on the weekend, one was offered at one site (a nearby Catholic Church in the next town) and one at the Church we were passing. Both Churches share the same pastor. We are fortunate in our cluster to have sister parishes within close proximity of one another. It is my understanding back when clustering began that the idea was to coordinate Mass Schedules so if a parishioner couldn't make it to Mass at their parish for convenience, they could attend a nearby Parish.

After we drop our 12:00 pm Mass in our Cluster, consisting of us as well as Blessed Trinity, St. Ignatius and St. Mel's, there's still the opportunity to attend a Saturday Vigil Mass at 4:00 pm, 4:30 pm and two at 5:00 pm. On Sunday, there's an opportunity to attend Mass beginning at 7:00 am, 8:00 am, two at 9:00 am, 9:30 am 10:30 am, two at 11:00 am and one at 11:30 am. If we add Our Lady of Angels and St. Patrick's, there's an opportunity to also attend a Saturday Vigil Mass at 4:00 pm and 4:30 pm and an 8:30 am, 9:00 am and two 11:00 am Masses. This is a good thing because we are so close to one another and even though there is a clergy shortage there's still a number of Masses available for our Faithful within say a few miles of our Parish. We are the only Parish to offer an 8:00 am and 10:30 am on Sunday so we are doing our part in the clustering process.

I think one thing we can also look at is offering some adult formation programs periodically after the 10:30 am Mass once the 12:00 pm Mass is gone. This would give an opportunity for those who can't make it during the week or at night to attend, and still have Sunday afternoon open. Maybe we can even talk Fr. Manning into teaching us about the history of our Diocese.

Once again, thank you for your support and understanding. I wish you, as always, a Blessed week.
