A few months ago Tom Borawski Jr. came up to me and asked if he could hang the portraits of the Pastor's on the wall of the East entrance of the Church. The portraits had hung previously in the school. Last week he made that idea a reality. If you see him please give him a thumbs up. He did a good job. I said since you're in the mood to hang pictures how about hanging the Divine Mercy picture of Jesus on the screen behind the Baptismal Font. Deacon Ken uses this picture for Divine Mercy Sunday and also the monthly recitation of the Divine Mercy Chaplet that takes place the first Sunday of each month at 3:00 p.m. Scott Mead our plant manager, Tom Borawski and Mark Constantine will work on installing track lighting similar to the lighting we have on the Holy Family setting. This will help to better illuminate the Baptismal Font and Divine Mercy Picture.
