# PASTOR'S NOTES

Dear Parishioners,

This past weekend during the 10:30am Mass a number of cars were broken into. According to our security cameras, the incident took place around 10:35 am and was over by about 10:38am. There were 2 individuals involved. One remained in a vehicle and also acted as a look out and the other who actually broke into the vehicles. The officer who responded checked the security cameras and was able to obtain a license plate on the vehicle. It turns out the vehicle had been stolen earlier that morning. He was also able to conclude that we were the third location hit that morning by this duo. He felt confident at that time they were still in the area and made sure all other units were updated. The parish will provide a copy of the incident to the police department and if asked to prosecute will not hesitate. We were told this incidence of "Smash and Grab" are on the increase and it's important to always keep the vehicles locked as well as hide any valuables from eyesight. This is the first incident in a long while where our parishioner's property had been involved, nevertheless it's still unnerving that we've reached the point that not even church property is sacred to common thugs.

Next Sunday is Palm Sunday and the beginning of Holy Week. The following is the Holy Week and Easter Schedule for St. Vincent de Paul Parish. The Sacrament of Reconciliation will be offered on Saturday April 8th as usual from 3:30pm-4:30pm. In addition the opportunity for Confession will also take place on Tuesday April 11<sup>th</sup> from 1:30 pm until 2:30pm and on Spy Wednesday April 12th after the 6:00pm Mass until 8:00pm. Please note this will be the last opportunity for scheduled confessions until the Saturday after Easter, April 22.

The Mass of The Lord's Supper will take place on Holy Thursday at 7:00pm. The Blessed Sacrament will be reposed on the Holy Family Altar until 10:00pm.

Good Friday there will be an opportunity to attend and pray the Stations of the Cross at 12:00pm. Later in the afternoon there will be the opportunity to attend the Good Friday Passion of the Lord Liturgy that includes the opportunity to venerate the Cross.

Parish offices are closed on Good Friday.

On Holy Saturday at 12:00pm we will have the annual Easter Egg Hunt.

At 1:00 pm we will offer the traditional Blessing of the Food.

The Easter Vigil will be at 9:00pm.

(Please note there will not be a Saturday 5:00pm Vigil Mass on Holy Saturday in accordance with Church Law.)

Easter Sunday the Mass times will be 8:00am 10:30am & 12:00pm.

On Divine Mercy Sunday April 23<sup>rd</sup> we will offer the recitation of the Divine Mercy Novena and Benediction at 3:00pm.
