Chaplet of Divine Mercy and Benediction is on the First Sunday of the month at 3:00 pm.

Marriages require a six month preparation period by Diocesan policy. Call one of the parish priests prior to setting a date.

Funerals: Arrangements are to be made at the Parish Office before publication of the death notice.

Ministry to those who are Sick or Shut-In

Our Eucharistic Ministers can bring the Eucharist to those parishioners who are ill, recovering from a hospital stay, shut-in, or otherwise unable to attend the Liturgies each Sunday. Please call the Parish Office to be placed on the schedule.

The Reverend Albert A. Kunkel, Pastor Emeritus, Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish, Barberton, died Sunday, March 26, 2017. Fr. Kunkel was ordained to the priesthood on May 18, 1957 by Archbishop Edward F. Hoban. Fr. Kunkel's first assignment was as Parochial Vicar of St. Vincent de Paul Church, Cleveland. Fr. Kunkel was a kind and gentle soul who lived his life for others. Good Friday there will be an opportunity to attend and pray the Stations of the Cross at 12:00 pm. At 3:00 pm in the afternoon, there will be the opportunity to attend the Good Friday Passion of the Lord Liturgy and Veneration of the Cross.

On **Holy Saturday** at 12:00 pm, we will have the annual Easter Egg Hunt **outside** rain or shine. At 1:00 pm, we will offer the traditional Blessing of the Food.

The **Easter Vigil** will be at 9:00 pm. (Please note there will not be a Saturday 5:00 pm Vigil Mass on Holy Saturday in accordance with Church Law.

Easter Sunday Mass times will be 8:00 am, 10:30 am, & 12:00 pm.

PASTOR'S NOTES

Dear Parishioners,

Palm Sunday commemorates the triumphal entrance of Christ into Jerusalem when palm branches were placed in His path before His arrest on Holy Thursday and His Crucifixion on Good Friday. It marks the beginning of Holy week, the final week of Lent, and the week in which we Catholic

Christians celebrate the mystery of our salvation through Christ's Death and His Resurrection on Easter Sunday.

Please consider joining us during this Holiest week of the year. On Holy Thursday evening at 7:00 pm, we commemorate the celebration of the Lord's Supper and institution of the Priesthood. At the end of this Mass there will be a solemn procession of the Eucharist to the Holy Family Altar where it will be reposed for adoration until 10:00 pm.

On Good Friday, Stations of the Cross will be offered at 12:00 pm. At 3:00 pm there will be the Good Friday Service. The service consists of three parts: the Liturgy of the Word, which includes the reading of the Lord's Passion; the opportunity to venerate the Cross, and the opportunity to receive Holy Communion.

On Holy Saturday evening we will celebrate the beginning of the Easter Season. We will begin the day with the annual Easter Egg Hunt for the children of our parish on the front lawn of the school. The event is at 12:00 pm and is sponsored by the Holy Name Society. It will occur rain or shine. The traditional Blessing of the Food will occur at 1:00 pm in the Church. Later in the evening starting at 9:00 pm we will celebrate the Easter Vigil and proclaim that Jesus has indeed risen from the dead. On Sunday we will have our regular Mass schedule at 8:00 am, 10:30 am and 12:00 pm.

During Holy Week the Sacrament of Reconciliation will be offered on Tuesday afternoon from 1:30 pm until 2:30 pm and on Wednesday after the 6:00 pm Mass until 8:00 pm. There are no scheduled confessions after Wednesday evening.

Also according to Canon Law there is no morning Mass on Holy Thursday and Good Friday. There is only one Mass on Holy Saturday that is the Vigil at 9:00pm.

As is tradition at St. Vincent de Paul, the parish offices will be closed on Good Friday.

Please see the insert in today's bulletin concerning the Divine Mercy Novena which begins on Good Friday. A Free Leaflet containing the Novena will be available at all of the Church Entrances to help you begin this wonderful and powerful devotion. Revealed to St. Faustina Kowalska in 1930, the devotion carries Christ's promises of "unimaginable graces, the conversion of sinners, and a happy death."
