Happy Mother's Day to all of our mothers, grandmothers and those ladies who have had an important role in our lives. Remember to stop by the Bake Sale sponsored by the SVDP Marketing Committee after all the Masses this weekend. Pro-

ceeds will help fund the parish picnic.

Last week I met for the second time with a representative from a company that sells and installs stair lifts. We will be eventually installing a chair lift on the stairs by the East entrance of the Church. The chair lift will be commercial grade with a weight capacity of 400 pounds. It will have two 12 volt batteries to ensure dependable performance even in a power outage. Eventually it may be possible to have a chair lift that can be used to access the Social Hall. This would have to be at another entrance because the two stairwells that lead to the social hall at the East side entrance are too narrow to hold a chair lift and still permit walking traffic. This being the case it would not pass a fire inspection. I will keep you updated on this.
