Human beings are prone to grumbling. In the book of Exodus, the Israelites, having been freed from slavery in Egypt and watched God destroy their enemies in the Red Sea, complain that they are in the wilderness with no food to eat. They grumble that God should have left them as slaves back in Egypt, where they at least were provided with three square meals a day. It never seems to occur to them that the God who was powerful enough to free them from slavery might also be powerful enough to provide them with food. God replies to their grumbling with characteristic generosity, raining down bread from heaven to sustain them.

What will make us stop grumbling and placing demands upon God? Perhaps it would mean doing a little less grumbling and a little more trusting. Small, daily acts of gratitude are the foundation of our life in Christ.
